

THE JOURNEY OF EMPLOYMENT EXCHANGE

Directorate General of Resettlement & Employment, July 1945 , for demobilized / discharged defense personnel/ war workers through Employment Exchanges.

Employment services for all categories of job seekers in 1948 Directorate General of Employment and Training now.

Based on the recommendations of Shiv Rao committee (1952) on Training and Employment Service Committee, administrative control of the E.Ex was given to the states w.e.f. 1/11/1956

Employment Exchanges (Compulsory Notification of Vacancies) Act 1959 enacted within the framework of ILO convention no 88. Notification of vacancies arising in all the public sector establishments and non-agricultural establishments in the private sector employing 25 or more workers is compulsory.

Forty-second Report of the Standing Committee on 'The Employment Exchanges (Compulsory Notification of Vacancies) Amendment Bill, 2013 was presented to Lok Sabha/laid in Rajya Sabha on 7th February, 2014.

Introduction of National Career Service Project and the national portal on 20/07/2015. Up gradation of the E .Ex. as Career Centres. Interlinking of the Employment Exchanges, Vacancy, postings, job searches etc through the portal.

The Department of Labour Resources, Govt. of Bihar has approved to facilitating Career Services through the NCS portal from 01/11/2016

Notification regarding mandatory posting of public sector vacancies on the NCS portal. Directorate General of Employment.
